- **Hanuman Temple:** ~100 years old

- Heavy loss reported this year due to climatic conditions.
- Total trees in village: 3000–4000
- 50 trees planted near school.
- Groundwater available at approx. 70 ft depth.

## **Infrastructure Status**

- Roads constructed (₹8.25 crore project)
- Gram Panchayat Office well maintained
- Waste management system needs improvement
- Garbage vehicle availability limited
- Open drainage and stagnant wastewater observed

## **Environmental & Sanitation Issues**

From field observation (photo evidence):

- Open drainage with stagnant dirty water
- Improper solid waste disposal
- Plastic waste accumulation
- Risk of mosquito breeding
- Need for structured waste management

## **8. Observations**

- Water is available but needs proper management and monitoring. Problems identified
- Poor waste management system
- Open drainage system
- Water stagnation in some areas
- Limited garbage collection facilities
- Need for awareness regarding cleanliness

1. Implement 7-step waste management system
2. Regular garbage collection vehicle
3. Covered drainage system
4. Awareness programs on Swachh Bharat Mission
5. Rainwater harvesting awareness
6. Regular water quality testing
7. Plantation drive expansion

Through this activity, students developed:



## **11. Conclusion**



The activity enhanced practical learning and social awareness among students.


